STUDENTS NEW TO THE “RISING SUN HIGH SCHOOL” SCHOOL DISTRICT

Welcome to Rising Sun High School! We currently carry the largest enrollment of students of the five Cecil County High Schools. We have approximately 1200 students enrolled from Conowingo and Port Deposit to Elkton, Maryland.

If you now reside in the Rising Sun High School district and need to register your student(s) in our school you will need to be sure to call and speak with our Guidance Secretary, Mrs. Loomis, to schedule an appointment with a counselor.

Next, you will need to be sure to withdraw your student from their current school and be sure all books have been returned and debts cleared. As a courtesy, the school from which you are withdrawing should provide you with a packet of information for enrollment purposes. Many schools do not provide this courtesy but ask that we fax a “Consent To Release Records” form at the time you register with us.

When enrolling with us you will need to bring in the following:

- ❖ Birth Certificate
- ❖ Social Security Card
- ❖ Up To Date Immunization Information
- ❖ Proof of Residency That You Do Reside in our School District (with correct Street Address on the Document)
 - Power Bill
 - Phone Bill
 - Rental or Lease Agreement
 - Property Tax Bill
 - Settlement Papers
- ❖ High School Transcript Showing All Credits Earned or Middle School Transcript Showing Student Has Successfully Completed Grade 08. Please request this from the previous school prior to your scheduled appointment.
- ❖ Current Schedule with Grades At Time of Withdrawal and the Last Marking Period Report Card.

If a student is transferring from a Non-Accredited High School they will be required to take Credit-By-Examination for courses for which they have received credits.
