**Unit:** Families/Citizenship

**Week of:** Nov. 16

**Activities:** This week we will be working on letter li-Iggy Iguana. We will read the story Little Red Hen and discuss the good and bad choices in the story. After listening to the story we will put it in sequential order. Another story we will read is The Three Bears. As a class we will discuss Goldilocks choices. In Math, we will continue to work on the 5 groups and math stories. In Social Studies we will continue to talk about being a good citizen. Right now we are also preparing for our Friends and Family Day!

**Home Help:** This week our sight words are: can, at, we. Please continue to review other sight words that have already been introduced.

<b>Monday</b>	Tell 5 math stories to your child. An example would be: I have 5 chicken nuggets on my plate and I get 1 more. How many do I have in all ? Then have your child do some. This is one of the skills we are working on in Math.
<b>Tuesday</b>	Find items in your house that are gray. Then draw one of those items. Next label (write the word) the picture with the color word gray. Turn in tomorrow Challenge: write a sentence using the color word gray
<b>Wednesday</b>	Give your child a sound and let them tell you a word that begins with that sound. Example: Give me a word that makes the /s/ sound. Answer: snake. Use the following sounds: /r/, /p/, /f/, /c/, /w/, /m/, and /b/.
<b>Thursday</b>	At home give your child pennies and see if they can show you a five group for numbers 6-10. Ex. 6 is 5 and 1, so your child would have 5 pennies in a group and then 1.
<b>Friday</b>	No Homework!
