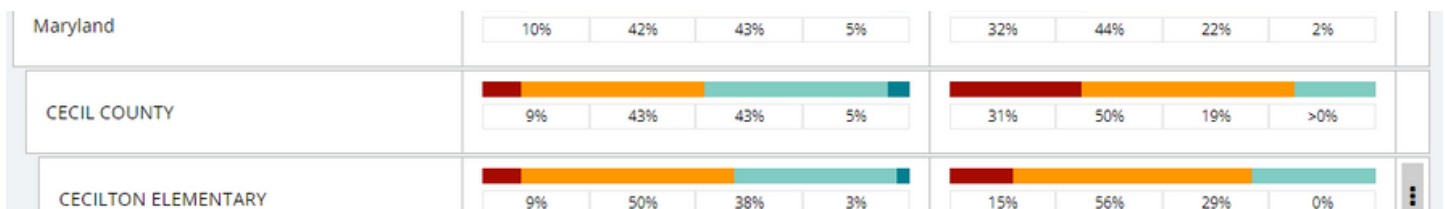
## Interesting Tidbits
