What is the *Green Zone*?

Green is good! Students work to earn *Green Zone* status each marking period. Students who have earned *Green Zone* status are rewarded with a special group celebration. *Green Zone* students must meet the following criteria:

- ***No more than 1 Office Discipline Referral (ODR), NO BUS SUSPENSIONS, and NO SUSPENSIONS from school for each marking period***

GREEN ZONE CELEBRATIONS

Students who have remained in the *Green Zone* each marking period will have the opportunity to participate in quarterly *Green Zone* celebrations. Spontaneous rewards will occur throughout the school year to promote and acknowledge positive student behaviors.

MEERKAT MONEY

Students who display exceptional behaviors will be acknowledged through the use of Meerkat Money. Any staff member can give Meerkat Money as recognition for displaying examples of school wide expectations (RRCS). Students who earn Meerkat Money have the opportunity to have their names drawn for prizes.
