Recommended Action	Superintendent's Recommendation: I recommend that the Board of Education of Cecil County reject all bids and not award RFP 19-17: Field House at Perryville High School due to unavailable funding.

### Public Content

Bids were opened in the Cecil County Public Schools' Board Room at the George Washington Carver Education Leadership Center on January 31, 2019, at 2:00 p.m. for Bid# 19-17: New Field House at Perryville High School. A Notice to Contractors was posted on the eMaryland Marketplace bidding board on January 14, 2019, with email notifications sent to prospective contractors. Prospective Contractors were also notified through Garden Reprographics, a construction document service provider, as well as the Cecil County Chamber of Commerce. The Notice to Contractors was posted onto the CCPS.org website on January 14, 2019.

The Perryville High School field house project is planned at approximately 4,995 square feet, constructed of masonry block with locker rooms, public restrooms, an equipment drying room, coaches offices, an athletic training room, a storage room, a potential concessions area, and a mechanical room contained in the attic area.

A pre-bid meeting was held on-site on January 22, 2019. It was attended by seventeen (17) contractors and six (6) CCPS staff members.

Seven (7) bids were received from the following:

3. Commonwealth Construction Company
4. DuBois Construction Inc.
5. Mullan Contracting Company
6. Plano Coudon Construction
7. Reilly Construction

On behalf of the Capital Outlay department, the Purchasing department recommends that the Board of Education of Cecil County reject all bids, and not award a contract for this solicitation, due to the unavailability of funding.
