Superintendent's Recommendation: I recommend that the Board of Education of Cecil County approve and award RFP #20-07 Chesapeake City Elementary School - Materials Inspection & Testing Services to ATC Group Services LLC of Columbia,

Maryland, for a total price of \$98,224.

RFPs were opened at Cecil County Public Schools at the George Washington Carver Education Leadership Center on August 8, 2019, at noon (ET) Local Time. A Notice to Contractors was posted on the eMaryland Marketplace bidding board, with email notifications sent to contractors. Prospective Contractors were also notified through Garden Reprographics, a construction document service provider, as well as posted onto the CCPS.org website on July 23, 2019.

Cecil County Public Schools Solicited the services of a qualified Materials Inspection & Testing Services Company (Firm) for the construction project at the new Chesapeake City Elementary School. The project is to be an approximately 64,000 gross sq. ft., two-story elementary school building in Chesapeake City, Maryland, with a project budget of approximately \$21 million.

On behalf of the Capital Outlay Department, the Purchasing Department recommends an award of a contract to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder which is ATC Group Services LLC of Columbia, Maryland, with a total Bid price of \$98,224. This project will be funded by Capital Improvement funds (CIP).
