Maryland Report Card

The Maryland Report Card summarizes how a school performed on the Maryland accountability system. The results reflect school performance in multiple areas, including: Academic Achievement, Academic Progress (for elementary and middle schools), School Quality, and Student Success, as well as Graduation Rates and College and Career Readiness (for high schools).

These results are an important snapshot of how a school is performing. They show areas where a school is doing well, and illuminate those where a school needs to improve. The information provided on the Report Card is displayed in a way that makes it easy to understand a school's performance. While the final score on the Report Card does not tell the whole story, we hope the Maryland School Report Card will add to our community discussions about how to constantly improve our schools.
