At Cecil Manor, supporting our students' academic and behavior needs is a foundational part of who we are, and we strive to provide each child with what s/he requires for success. We are in year 10 as a PBIS school. We've had great success with this program and recently received the Gold Award from PBIS Maryland for the fourth consecutive year. One new addition to our program is the school-wide administration of the Systematic Screening for Behavior Disorders. This screening will allow us to identify students who need tier II supports for both externalizing and internalizing behaviors. This support is provided through our Check-In/Check-Out program, where students have goals aligned to the screener results and work with in-school mentors to support their needs. Relationship building is important to us at Cecil Manor and we value the partnerships we've forged with our parents and community to support our students. These partnerships are vital to the health and well-being of our students and make Cecil Manor a terrific place for our families to call their school!

The purpose of this classroom is to provide students with significant behavior needs a place to have intensive supports and therapy. The goal of the program is to have qualifying students improve their behaviors and transition back to their home schools after first transitioning into regular education classrooms here at Cecil Manor. Our BSC teachers send support staff members with students as they are transitioning to provide assistance during this process to help ensure student success. Over the past two school years, we have successfully transitioned nine of our students into their home schools.
