

Math Night

Last week we had about 100 adults and students attend our Math Night. We enjoyed being able to share dinner with our families and provide tools to help families support their children at home in the area of math. This event utilized some of our Title I Funds and our School Funds. We look forward to seeing our families in March for our Reading Night.

School Advocacy

I'm sure most everyone has noticed the increase in media exposure having to do with the projected cuts next year if our school system does not receive over the lowest required funding (MOE) from our county government. If you did not tune into the livestream, please take some time to view the video from the Board of Education Special Budget Session HERE. Additional resources to gain important information about the proposed cuts, information about the budget process, and advocating for our school system can be found on the ccps.org webpage or through groups such as Fund CCPS or CCPS Facts.

At the end of the meeting, our Board of Education (BOE) asked Dr. Lawson to prepare a budget without those extensive cuts so they could vote on a budget aligned to the school district's strategic plan and what is actually needed for our students, staff, and school buildings. This budget will be shared with the BOE on Wednesday, February 7th. Prior to this meeting the County Council will be meeting on Tuesday, February 6th. I urge families to attend the Budget Session as well as advocate for our schools at the County Council meeting during the public comment portion of the meeting at 7pm. Each citizen has four uninterrupted minutes to share their thoughts with the Council without fear of possibly being put in a situation of a public argument ensuing. Mr. Moon, our music teacher, spoke at the last Council meeting. Mr. Moon or I would be glad to speak to anyone wanting to speak at the February 6th meeting or future council meetings prior to the passing of the County's Budget moved forward by Ms. Danielle Hornberger.
