A Final Note

Last week I began to talk about the impact of flat funding (Maintenance of Effort) on our school. I also talked about how we can change the future of school funding through voting in the Primary Election in May. I urged everyone to learn about the candidates running for County Executive and their views on the educational budget.

This week, I'm going to turn my attention to how to advocate and become informed about our school system. Have you ever attended a School Board meeting? Through your attendance, you are not only showing your support for education but learning first hand the business of CCPS. *All meetings will be held at the George Washington Carver Education Leadership Center, 201 Booth Street, Elkton, unless otherwise noted on the schedule.* You can find the schedule by clicking this <u>LINK</u>. Another way to get involved is through the Citizens Advisory Committee. Those meetings are also held at the George Washing Carver Education Leadership Center and all meetings are open to the public. The next meeting is February 13th at 6pm.

Finally, attending County Council meetings wearing red is a way to show your support for Education. You can also speak on behalf of our school and our students to advocate for increased funding. Did you know when you speak the council can only listen? I find that takes the fear out of speaking in front of the group. The Council members and the County Executive need to hear directly from our families in a public forum. It is too easy for them to ignore emails or letters. Here is a list of meeting dates:
