Guidelines for Interpreting this Calendar

- -Denotes school holiday for students and staff.
- -Denotes schools closed for students and 10-month staff.
- -Denotes Professional Day – Schools closed for students.
- ⬠ -Denotes Inclement Weather Make-Up Days. If not used, schools closed for students and 10-month staff.
- ⊙ -Denotes Inclement Weather Make-Up Days. If not used, Professional Day for staff, school closed for students.

Graduation Date:

Graduation window is scheduled for June 3-5

Early Dismissals

- Elementary students are dismissed early each Wednesday to provide planning and staff development time for teachers.
- Secondary students will be dismissed early the last 3 days* of school.
- Elementary students will be dismissed early the last day* of school.

* Official notification of these days at the end of the year and whether they will be scheduled as early dismissal will be determined as soon as possible after the inclement weather season.

Inclement Weather Make-up Days:

Inclement weather make-up days will be used in the following order:

- March 26, 2021
- May 28, 2021
- April 7, 2021
- April 6, 2021
- June 16**, 17, 18, 21 & 22

**If not used as inclement weather make-up day, schools will be closed for students; professional days for staff.

If the total number of days missed exceeds the designated number of inclement weather make-up days, then additional time will be added to the school day or school year to satisfy the requirements of the state.

Marking Periods:

- 1st – September 1 - November 9
- 2nd – November 10 - January 27
- 3rd – January 28 – April 9
- 4th – April 12 - June 15

Please note marking periods are subject to change due to inclement weather.
