All students will be dismissed early (secondary first, then elementary) on January 14, February 18, March 11, March 24, and May 6, 2022. Secondary students will be dismissed early the last 3 days* of school.

- Elementary students will be dismissed early the last day of school.

 * Official notification of these days at the end of the year and whether they will be scheduled as early dismissal will be determined as soon as possible after the inclement weather season.
- Graduation will be scheduled by individual high schools and will occur between Thursday, June 2, and Saturday, June 4.
