


Denotes school holiday for students and all staff.
Denotes early dismissal (secondary first, then elementary)
Denotes Professional Day - schools closed for students
Denotes Inclement Weather Make-Up Days. If not used, schools closed for students and 10-month staff
Denotes Inclement Weather Make-Up Days. If not used, Professional Day for staff, schools closed for students.
Designated Inclement Weather Make-Up Days will be used in the following order:

- May 27 is inclement weather make-up day \#1.
- April 14 is inclement weather make-up day \#2.
- April 19 is inclement weather make-up day \#3.
- The next inclement weather make-up days will be June 10, 13, 14, and 15 .
- If the total number of days missed exceeds the designated number of inclement weather make-up days, additional time will be added to the school day or school year to satisfy the requirements of the state.
(1) Early Dismissals:

Elementary students are dismissed early each Wednesday to provide planning and staff development time for teachers.
All students will be dismissed early (secondary first, then elementary) on January 14, February 18, March 11, March 24, and May 6, 2022.
Secondary students will be dismissed early the last 3 days* of school.
Elementary students will be dismissed early the last day* of school.

* Official notification of these days at the end of the year and whether they will be scheduled as early dismissal will be determined as soon as possible after the inclement weather season
(2) Graduation will be scheduled by individual high schools and will occur between Thursday, June 2, and Saturday, June 4.
